The **CURRICULUM** of the training cycle of top grade of Plastic Arts and Design in FURNISHING is divided into 17 MODULES taught in the center and developed during two academic courses, in addition to the Training module in Workplace that takes place at the end of the second course.

For the student accredits the knowledge and skills acquired, he/she must perform a FINAL PROJECT, which will develop once passed positively all the modules mentioned above.

Given the characteristics of some disciplines taught and given physical conditions that the School possesses; on occasions, it is essential that students develop part of their lesson time outside the centre, in other public spaces. Due to this circumstance, it is essential that the outputs of the centre are authorized by the legal representatives of the students.

EVALUATION, PROMOTION and RETENTION

To obtain the **TITLE of TECHNICIAN of PLASTIC ARTS and DESIGN in FURNISHING** is necessary a positive assessment in all the modules that comprise the curriculum; both the imparted in the educational centre and the phase of training in centres of work and the realization of a FINAL PROJECT cycle.

By the final draft, which will be overcome once all the modules have passed, the student must demonstrate mastery of the knowledge acquired, as well as practical preparation for professional practice.

The negative rating in more than two modules will prevent the promotion of the first to the second course. In this case, students should only study modules that had not passed.

The students will have to overcome each module four calls (two per academic year). On an exceptional basis, an extraordinary call in cases of disease that prevents the normal development of studies or others that deserve equal consideration may be authorized.

REVIEW of QUALIFICATIONS

Students may request clarifications on their final grades to their teachers in the 24 hours following its publication. In the case of a persisting disagreement and, when grades are final nature, they may apply for review in writing to the Head of Studies within two school days to the request for clarification or publication of the claimed rating.

When students are minors, it will assist the parents or legal guardians during the process of clarification and claims.

RULES, contained in the INTERNAL REGIME REGULATIONS

- 1. Relationships that exist between the different components of all walks of life of the centre shall be governed at all times with respect and consideration towards others criteria.
- 2. They shall comply with and respect the timetable approved for the correct development of the different activities of the school.
- They will care and use properly the movable property and the facilities of the centre, as well as respecting the belongings of the other members of the educational community.
- 4. Class attendance, for being accredited courses, is obligatory.
- 5. Students must remain in the educational area throughout their teaching day, collected in the schedules of each group; and must not leave school without express permission of the teachers.
- 6. Class changes will be maximum diligence possible by teachers and students, because there is not a period of time between classes.
- 7. In the course of any teaching activity it is not allowed the use of mobile phones or other electronic devices that disrupt the normal development of the activity, being optional to each teacher its eventual use according to reasonable and exceptional circumstances.
- 8. The student must follow the orientations of teachers with respect to their learning.
- 9. You must attend class on time and participate in the activities.
- 10. No class attendance without justifying more than 15% of the total number of classes by subject will lead to automatic loss of the continuous assessment on the subject involved. In this case to positively overcome the module you should go to a final exam.
- 11. Three absences of punctuality are counted as a lack of assistance.
- 12. Regardless of class attendance, to overcome positive materials, the student must submit 100% of the work envisaged in curriculum design.
- 13. Students will have to present personal authorization, if they are adult, and if they are minor, authorization of the person having parental authority, for all the activities that require departures from the school, in Palencia, province, provinces or cities.
- 14. Work tools used in class to the completion of the teaching time will be collected by the students.
- 15. At the end of the class, the student will also check that it leaves his post in appropriate conditions of order and cleanliness.
- 16. The student will continue to indications of the teacher regarding the handling of all types of machinery, as well as with the obligations in the field of safety and health at work.
- 17. Each group of students during the first fifteen days of each course will elect two delegates, who will be the valid partners in other levels of school and will become part of the board of delegates of students.





SUBJECTS:

Access on the left may be the most useful, allowing quick access to FILES, WEB SITES, AND CALENDAR of all the subjects in which you are enrolled.





ADS:

To see news of interest concerning academic or extracurricular activities organized by subjects.



CALENDAR:

To check the dates of exams, delivery of works and other appointments set by teachers of different subjects.




FILES:
